Have you already saved the date? WordCamp Genève will take place on Saturday, 9 April 2022!

This WordCamp celebrates the much-awaited revival of face-to-face events and the return to normality after two difficult years. We very much missed the talks, as well as the opportunity to meet friends and new acquaintances, talk about WordPress or any other web topic and have a drink and a meal together in the evening.

What is a WordCamp? It's a day of talks focused on WordPress and related topics. Anyone can attend, from casual WordPress users to development specialists. The aim is to share ideas, share experience, broaden and deepen knowledge and establish new contacts. WordCamps are inclusive events; everyone is welcome. We have published an <a href="entire post">entire post</a> on this topic.

This is why we were eager to organise this WordCamp! This event is actually the one we originally planned for 2020, but it was then postponed. It follows a series of WordCamps in Switzerland: 2019 in Zurich, 2018 in Lausanne, 2017 in Bern, 2016 in Geneva and 2014/2015 in Zurich. We are, in fact, the "WordCamp Switzerland", which is open to everyone. Some of the talks will be held in English to suit people from all language backgrounds. We have prepared a great programme and have recontacted the 2020 speakers we had to cancel 3 weeks before the event, owing to the outset of the pandemic. We also have 3 new guests who will take you through practical workshops. You'll find the complete programme here and the list of speakers here.

We've organised the day in a way to enable a day trip to Geneva, even if you're coming from the other end of Switzerland! You can find more information regarding travelling to Geneva in this post.

For those of you who intend to stay on in the evening: the <u>after-party</u> will consist of a sumptuous meal prepared on-site by the Birdhouse restaurant. The same team will also prepare lunch for us and coffee throughout the day. This social foundation helps, among other things, to reintegrate young people who have dropped out of school. We are proud to be associated with Birdhouse for our event.



A contribution day? This is a well-established asset in most WordCamps. However, this year, we wanted to offer an "Introduction to contribution" session. We'll show you that any degree of knowledge or level of skills is welcome to participate in this beautiful open-source WordPress project. JB Audras, who is a core contributor, will present this introduction. Experienced contributors are also welcome to attend this workshop, which will continue throughout the day around "The Table".

WordCamps are affordable events: you will benefit from the whole programme for only CHF 25, including lunch and dinner. You can also become a microsponsor for CHF 150 -, a price that is still below the day's effective cost per person.
